



## **EY opening new HQ in Manhattan**

EY is opening new U.S. headquarters at One Manhattan West, a 67-story office tower under construction in Manhattan, authorities said.

The professional services firm, which has an office in Jericho, aims to create 1,152 jobs within seven years and occupy 17 floors of the new office tower, state officials said.

Richard Jeanneret, EY's vice chair and northeast region managing partner, described the office tower as "an inspiring, state-of-the-art environment in one of the best connected locations in the city," adding that it "aligns with EY's focus on innovation across all aspects of business."

Officials said the company would occupy 17 floors of the office tower.

EY is working with the Empire State Development, which offered up to \$12 million in performance-based tax credits through the Excelsior Jobs Program.

"Ernst & Young's decision to locate their national headquarters in the Empire State is proof that our diverse talent, thriving economy and unparalleled opportunities make us the economic capital of the world," Cuomo said in a statement.

"Global companies choose New York because of our skilled, diverse workforce, our investments in 21st century infrastructure, and our economic development strategies

designed to help businesses grow, succeed, and create jobs,” Empire State Development President, CEO, and Commissioner Howard Zensky said in a statement.

In addition to domain and regulatory experience, EY’s offerings have grown to include artificial intelligence, robotics process automation, blockchain, data analytics, digital, customer experience and cybersecurity.
